Arrow of Light Building a Better World Adventure 10d is to *connect with a Scout in another country during an event such as Jamboree on the Air.*

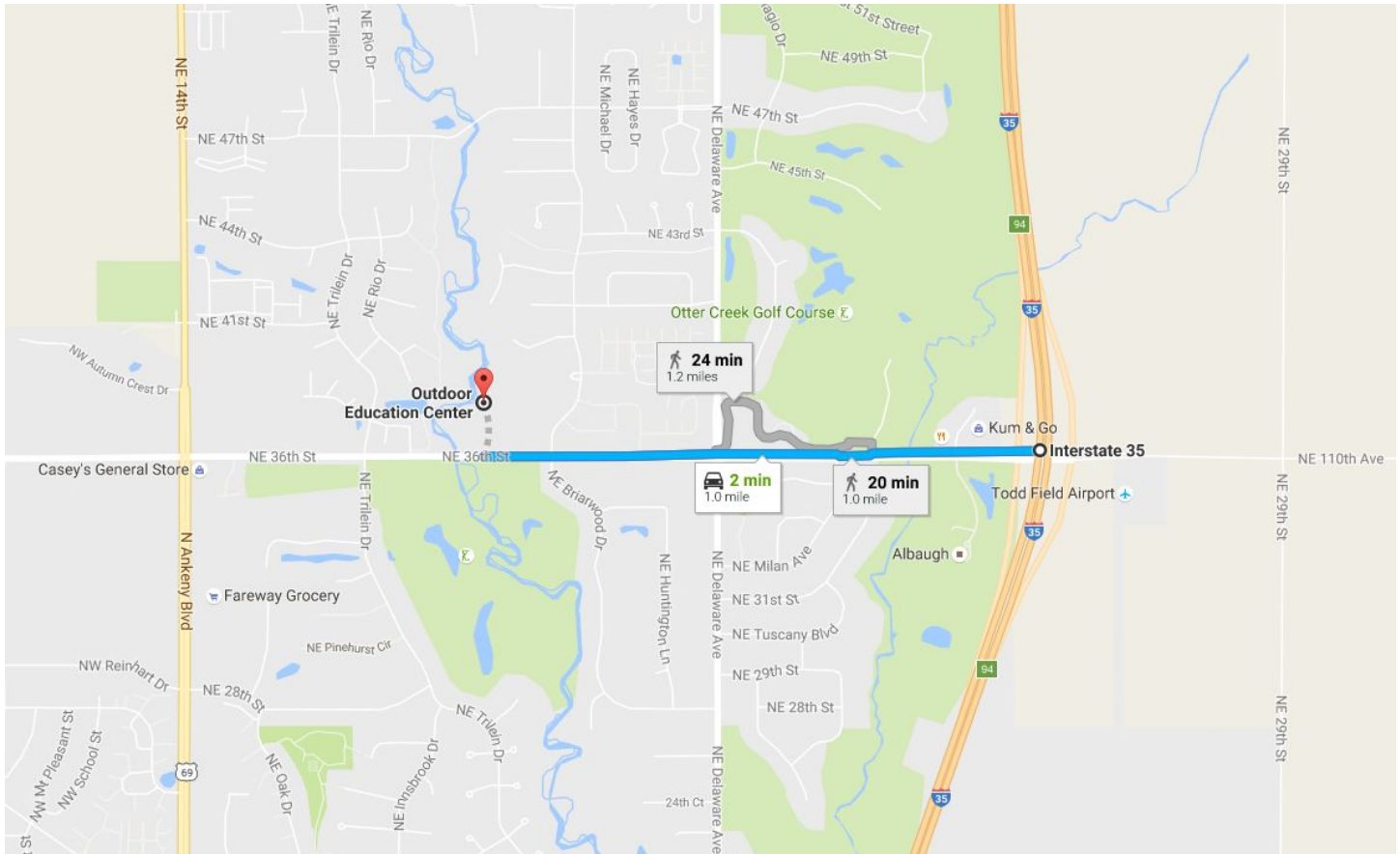
Citizenship in the World requirement 7e - *Participate in or attend an international event in your area, such as an ethnic festival, concert or play.*
