#### What do get for \$5.29?

By KAØFTO Larry

What do you get for \$5.29? You get a flashlight that requires just one Double A battery. Many small flashlights use 3 each Triple A. Really you get TWO flashlights in the package. I of course used an Alkaline battery. I wanted to know how long the battery would last. The flashlight is actually made out of metal 3 3/4" long and has an unrecognizable bulb!

I started with a fresh NORTH TECH old Orange and Black style Alkaline battery. Open circuit start voltage was 1.61 Volts. After being on for 16 hours there was still light (see figure 4) and pulling the battery and measuring it showed .75 Volts. It could have been used longer but was much dimmer but still a white light. I had no way to measure the current but obviously was low compared to my testing of batteries at another time. Another test with a Carbon-Zinc batter ran 9 hours with the voltage dropping to .7 Volts.

Fig 1 through 3 showed the light still on.

Fig 4 photo was taken in a lighted room right

before I removed the battery to measure the voltage.

Fig 5 Photo taken with new battery.

So why talk about a FLASHLIGHT? As some of us get older we require help and plenty of light to read small part numbers and copper foil patterns on circuit boards. This one is small and easy to carry. Note the clip to carry in your pocket.

Oh yes I purchased it a Menards.


